

How To: Find Music For Your Claymation

Read all directions before beginning!!

1. Open Internet Explorer or your favorite internet browser
2. Go to <http://freeplaymusic.com> This is a royalty-free music website. This means, that all of this music can be used in both private and commercial publications without paying the artist who created the music a fee (also known as a royalty). Typically, whenever music is used in any medium, the author of the music must be paid a fee for its usage. If this fee is not paid, technically, the use of the music has been stolen from the author. This is a real and serious crime. So, since we will be publishing our videos to youtube.com, we want to make sure we are not stealing from other artists. As such, we will be using royalty free music.
3. Browse the music and preview different tracks. Use headphones.
4. Once you've found something you like download it.
 - a. Click on the number of seconds you want to download (hint: you want more seconds than your video is long, so double check how long your video is by looking at your timeline in Windows Movie Maker)
 - b. A pop-up screen will appear
 - c. The pop-up screen will ask "do you want to open or save this file?"
 - d. Choose "save file"
 - e. Another pop-up screen will appear. This screen is asking where you want to save your music.
 - f. Scroll the folders window of the pop-up screen and click on "My Computer" and find your USB drive
 - g. Scroll to find the folder to which you are saving the files for your Claymation (you may have to make a new folder)
 - i. Click "Save"
 - j. Your music is now saved on your USB drive in your Claymation folder
